

Flag Staff Mount Installation – Cadillac (1997-1999) Part #: 40145

- 1. Cadillac flagstaff mounts are left side and right side specific. The left (driver side) flagstaff mount is marked with 'L'.
- 2. Open the hood.
- 3. Note the lips on the fenders, above the front wheels.
- 4. Select the desired location along the fender for the mount.
- 5. Hold the mount against the fender with the 3/8" hole over the fender. The mount should be at 90 degrees to the ground. A small level on top of the mount will help to determine 90 degrees to the ground. Mark one of the smaller hole locations on the inner fender.
- 6. At the hole location marked on the inner fender drill a 7/64" hole.
- 7. Secure the mount to the fender using a 5/8 inch #6 stainless steel pan head metal screw. A little grease in the drilled hole will help prevent the fender from rusting.
- 8. Try carefully closing the hood after each installation to ensure the hood clears the flagstaff mount.
- 9. Adjust the mount to 90 degrees and drill the second 7/64" hole.
- 10. Finish securing the mount with a second screw.
- 11. Once you are satisfied with the mount installation, attach the flagstaff base to the mount using the stainless steel nut and washer supplied.
